

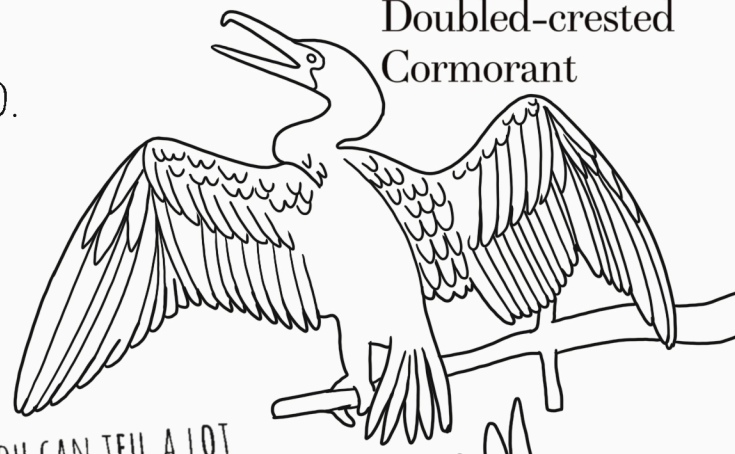

Doubled-crested Cormorant

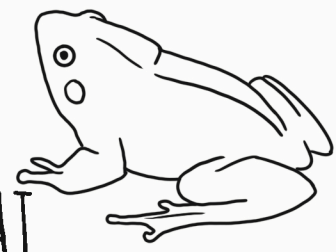

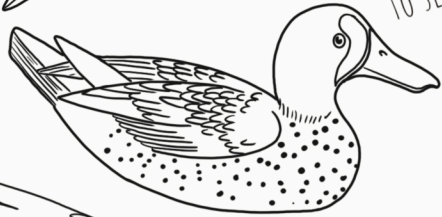


INSECTS

Small shorebirds with long legs feed mostly on insects that live in the water or in the mud.

PLANTS

The Blue-winged Teal is a duck that feeds on plants and seeds they find floating in the water. If they can, they will also eat snails or crustaceans.

Egrets like fish but also eat amphibians and other small animals like rodents.



FISH



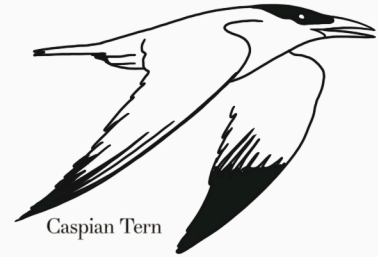
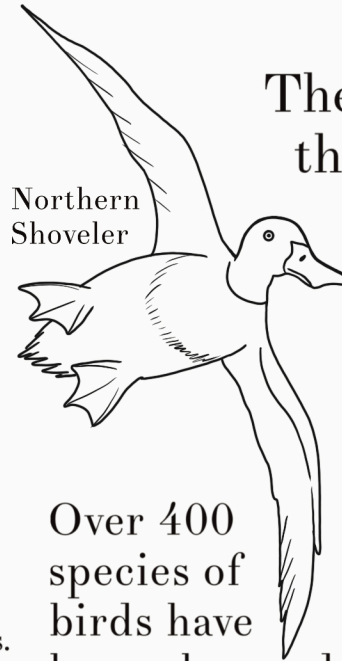
Pelicans gobble up fish whole. Osprey use their sharp talons to hunt fish, and cormorants catch fish with their beaks.
